






This book is written by DirtyFeet.

 make sure people who find it hard to see can get our information




 work with our consultation group to help meet our goals every year.




A consultation group is a team of people with disability who help us make sure our services can be used by everyone.

# Goal 2 Support people with disability to dance




#### We will


 give everyone in our programs access to information in Easy English



 make sure everyone in our programs has the chance to talk with each other




 make sure the buildings we use can be used by everyone.

## We will


 give everyone program dates at the start of each year
